We continue to pray about the rejuvenation of perpetual adoration in our Adoration Chapel. In six weeks, at the conclusion of our novena, Fr. Villone from the Missionaries of the Blessed Sacrament will speak on this gift.

As we prepare to open the 24 hour Perpetual Adoration sign-up, let us reflect on the value of being willing to make a sacrifice by spending one hour in the middle of night with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament so that our parish may have the great blessing of having Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration.

**Your sacrifice is the greatest expression of love.** Jesus sacrificed everything for the love of you and your salvation. Are you willing to make this sacrifice of your time for love for Him, that our parish may give Him the glory by having perpetual adoration of the Blessed Sacrament? When you are tired, remember that God is the Giver of Time. Sleep more peacefully knowing that your sacrifice means so much to Jesus. "Could you not spend one hour with me?" *Mt. 26:40.*

**Your sacrifice is the key to reparation of the world.** Evil must be overcome with good. Your hour with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament will repair for evils of the world and bring about peace on earth. Our Lady's "Peace Plan" calls for prayer, penance and sacrifice. "Let us be generous with our time in going to meet Jesus and ready to make reparation for the great evils of the world. Let your adoration never cease." (*Pope John Paul II, Dominicae Cenae*)

**Your sacrifice will bring souls to heaven.** The love you give to Jesus in this special sacrifice of your time will win pardon and forgiveness for those who do not know or love Him at all. He comes to bring so many graces and blessings, and yet so few come to receive them. "My God, I believe, I adore, I trust, and I hope and I love Thee. I beg pardon for all those who do not believe, do not adore, do not trust, do not hope, and do not love Thee."
