Rules

- All teams are welcome, regardless of experience with competitive cooking! If you are a first time team, reach out to the organizers and they can help you with tips, tricks, packing lists and timelines to get you started.
- This is not a KCBS sanctioned contest, but we will generally follow KCBS rules for garnish and meat. Feel free to use whatever heat source you prefer (gas and electric are allowed).
- Teams will adhere to the schedule unless specifically coordinated with the HSO organizer.
- Each team cooking space: Pits, cookers, trailers, motor homes, vehicles, tents or any other equipment shall not exceed the boundaries of the team's assigned cooking space. Fires shall not be built on the ground.
- Anchoring tents into the asphalt with stakes is prohibited.
- A dumpster will be provided on-site, however you must provide your own trash cans and bags for your waste.
- Do not put hot coals in the trash, a coal pit will be provided.
- There are limited electrical outlets available in the church parking lot. You are responsible for bringing your own extension cords and quality and availability of electrical service is not guaranteed. It is the team's responsibility to plan for a backup if electricity is required.
- This is not a KCBS sanctioned contest, but we will generally follow KCBS rules for garnish and meat. Feel free to use whatever heat source you prefer (gas and electric are allowed).
- All meat must be cooked on site, but can be trimmed at home.
- There is an entry fee of \$150 per team and is non-reimbursable.
- This is not a fund-raiser. All funds will be used for expenses associated with the event. Any excess funds from this year will be used for future Holy Smoke Off events.
- This is a family friendly event so please exhibit safe practices, be mindful of language and enjoy yourselves responsibly.

Entry Submission

- All BBQ entries shall be submitted within the time window set forth in the contest schedule. Failure to submit entries during that time will result in disqualification of that entry.
- Entries must be provided in the styrofoam clamshell provided by the contest organizer. The team number should be on the top of the box.

Judging

- Scoring and judging will follow KCBS rules and general procedures. Judges will be instructed on the rules, but may or may not have prior BBQ contest judging experience.
- Scores will be provided via email following the conclusion of the contest.
- Category winners and Grand Champion will receive banners. Second and Third place will receive ribbons.
